Independent Auditor's Report on Quarterly and Year to Date Audited Financial Results of Mayurbhanj Trades and Agencies Limited Pursuant to the Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and DisclosureRequirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the 'Listing Regulations').

To The Board of Directors of Mayurbhanj Trades & Agencies Limited

1. We have audited the accompanying statement of financial results ("Statement") of Mayurbhanj Trades and Agencies Limited ("the "Company"), for the quarter ended 31st March, 2021 and the year-to date results for the period from 1st April, 2020 to 31st March, 2021, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("the Listing Regulations").

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the Statement:
