Notes to and forming part of the Statement of audited financial results for the quarter and year ended 31st March 2023:

- 1. The above financial results were reviewed by the Audit Committee and thereafter the Board of Directors has approved the above results at their respective meetings held on 26<sup>th</sup> May 2023.
- 2. In compliance with Regulation 33 of the Securities Exchange Board of India ("SEBI") (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015, an audit of financial results for the quarter and year ended 31st March 2023 has been carried out by the Statutory auditors. The statutory auditors have expressed an unmodified audit opinion.
- 3. As the company's business activity falls within a single primary business segment viz "Trading of Agricultural Products" the disclosure requirements of IND AS 108 "Operating Segments" are not applicable.
- 4. Storage and Other charges are payable at the time of release of agricultural products.
- 5. The Indian Parliament has approved the Code on Social Security, 2020 which would impact the contributions by the company towards Provident Fund and Gratuity. The Ministry of Labour and Employment has released draft rules for the Code on Social Security, 2020 on November 13, 2020, and has invited suggestions from stakeholders which are under active consideration by the Ministry. The Company will assess the impact and its evaluation once the subject rules are notified and will give appropriate impact in its financial statements in the period in which, the Code becomes effective and the related rules to determine the financial impact are published.
- 6. These financial results of the Company have been prepared in accordance with Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS) as prescribed under Section 133 of Companies Act 2013 read with Rule 3 of the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules 2015 and relevant amendment thereof.
- 7. Income Tax and Deferred Tax are calculated at the end of the year.
- 8. The company received 5 flats measuring 6050 sq.ft. in terms with joint development agreement. The flats have been capitalized during the year.
- 9. The figures for the quarters ended March 31, 2023 and March 31,2022 are the balancing figures between the audited figures in respect to full financial years and published unaudited year to date figures upto the year end of the third quarter of the relevant financial years which were under review
- 10. Previous period/ year's figures have been regrouped/restated wherever necessary to make them comparable with those of current period/year.
